

# Rugby Riding Club In Hand Points Scheme 2009



## What is the Rugby Riding Club In Hand Points Scheme?

The points scheme is designed so that members can collect their own points to go towards awards at the Annual General Meeting. To participate in the scheme, you must be a fully paid member of Rugby Riding Club for 2009.

## How do I collect points?

Points can be collected from any in hand show held by the Rugby Riding Club committee at Rugby Riding Club, which will be listed in the Calendar 2009. The points are shown in the table below:

	1 <sup>st</sup>	2 <sup>nd</sup>	3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 <sup>th</sup>	5 <sup>th</sup>	6 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Any In Hand Class</b>	100	80	70	60	50	40

There are also bonus points to be collected for championships:

<b>Champion</b>	100
<b>Reserve Champion</b>	80

To claim points, you must complete all the details on the Rugby Riding Club Points Scheme card. You must also get the show secretary, for that show, to sign the card.

## When do I need to return the card?

All cards will need to be returned at the end of the season and must be returned no later than 26<sup>th</sup> October 2009. Each card will then be checked and the points added up to go towards awards at the Annual General Meeting 2009.

## General Rules

1. The name of the handler, horse and the handler's Rugby Riding Club membership number must appear at the top of the points card and all continuation cards.
2. If a Non-Member becomes a member mid-way through the season, they can start to collect points from that date onwards. Points cannot be claimed for placings awarded whilst a Non-Member.
3. Only one card can be used per rider/horse combination, so if you intend to compete with two horses, you will need two cards – one for each horse.
4. Points can only be claimed for in hand classes. If you wish to collect ridden points, please use the separate ridden points card.
5. Full details must be provided for each class that you claim points for i.e. if you come 1<sup>st</sup> in Mountain and Moorland In Hand at the Spring Show.
6. Points will only count from March 2009 to October 2009.
7. Points will only count for classes held by the Rugby Riding Club Committee at Rugby Riding Club, as listed in the Calendar 2009.
